

Proverbs 20:29 (NKJV)

The glory of young men *is* their strength, And the splendor of old men *is* their gray head.

So whether or not you practice this way of treating the older people of this world with respect, this has been God's Will since the beginning. So keep this in mind when speaking to your elders.
