Likewise exhort the young men to be sober-minded, in all things showing yourself to be a pattern of good works; in doctrine showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility, sound speech that cannot be condemned, that one who is an opponent may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of you.

When we take the time to teach our children the precepts and principles of God's word, we are obeying His command to sincerely love one another. The youth are the future of our country. How much

brighter will that future be if we admonish our children in God's word? As Paul also said in Ephesians 6:1-4 (NKJV):

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. "Honor your father and mother," which is the first commandment with promise: "that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth." And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.
