Deuteronomy 6:4-7 (NKJV)

"Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one! You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.

Moses instructed us to prepare our children for their own spiritual journeys with God. As much as we want our children to develop their own identity in life, we must remember that if it does not include God they may grow to detest Him. Without the Lord, our children will be in danger of leading a misdirected life. I believe the Psalmist wrote it best when he used a bow and arrow as an example of how we can point our children in the right direction.

Psalm 127:3-5 (NKJV)

Behold, children *are* a heritage from the LORD, The fruit of the womb *is* a reward. Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, So *are* the children of one's youth. Happy *is* the man who has his quiver full of them; They shall not be ashamed, But shall speak with their enemies in the gate.
